

AFRICA



BENIN

A prayer based on Psalm 22:22-24.




ETHIOPIA

KAZAKHSTAN

Today, Kazakhstani, if you hear God's voice, do not harden your hearts. Do not turn away from Him, or be led astray by other religions and philosophies. Do not cause the Lord to be angry with you. A prayer based on Romans 5:1-5.




UZBEKISTAN
