China's focus on building military strength is seen as a threat by Taiwan as it continues to maintain its autonomy. Taiwan has continued to foster connections with sympathetic international allies. With a strong economy, Taiwan is a leader in computer technology. Unlike China, Taiwan seems more committed to freedom of religion though Christians only make up six percent of the population. Most are committed to the traditional ethnic religion. China's intervention in Hong Kong has caused many in Taiwan to be fearful of what their future holds.

#### **Call to Salvation**


Pray that many people will sense the emptiness in their hearts and recognize their need for a Savior (The Bible, Isaiah 43:1).
