Myanmar remains one of the most repressive regimes in Southeast Asia. Unable to yield power to successive elected governments, the military junta maintains complete control of the country. The persecution of minorities remains unchallenged locally or internationally. The Rohingyas, Christians, and other tribes suffer periodic violence at the hands of the military junta. Protests and demonstrations faced untold violence. Journalists and activists faced arrests and torture without reason. Yet, there is no real international pressure to end the persecution. Only The Gambia filed and won a ruling against the junta for the massacre of Rohingya in 2020.
