

- They have many ethnic beliefs as well. For example, some believe that men have the power to curse others by giving them the 'evil eye.'
- The majority of Turks live in their home country, but significant numbers live elsewhere.

- Their society is strictly male-dominated, and family and political rule belong to the men.





- Many thousands of Iraqi Arabs left Iraq following the 2003 Iraqi war, looking for stability and better economic opportunities in neighboring countries.
- Islam has greatly influenced the lives of Iraqi Arabs.

About The <u>People</u> Group:

- The Kurd Kurmanjis are tribal people and many of them lived, until recently, a nomadic lifestyle in the mountainous regions of Turkey, Syria, Iraq, and Iran.
- Today, Kurd Kurmanjis are the largest ethnic group in the world without a state of their own. Tribalism is still a factor among them, promoting many different factions which weaken the possibility of an independent homeland.
- In Turkey, where the largest contingent of Kurds live (40 %), the Kurds are seen as a threat by the Turkish government, which has continually sought to assimilate the Kurds into Turkish society through forced resettlement.

<u>Available</u> Resources:

- The Holy Bible (complete, both online and offline).
- The 'JESUS' film and other audio/video recordings.

- This people group is strongly fragmented and is often split by internal disagreements.
 So far in history, the Kurd - Kurmanjis have never really managed to unite in their common cause.
- Many Kurd Kurmanjis of the lower regions are not organized in tribes, but even there, strife is common between the different clans and communities.

ECONOMY



Physically, the Kurd - Kurmanjis live in very poor conditions. Good water supplies are scarce, and they are exposed to diseases such as malaria and tuberculosis.

Ask the LORD to call qualified Christian medical professionals who are willing to go and share their medical expertise as well as Jesus Christ with this people group.

EDUCATION



Schools are ill-equipped and there are too few of them. Kurd - Kurmanjis need the liberty to educate their children in their own language.

Pray for the Kurdish children to have access to wellequipped schools, and all other basic needs to continue their education.

RELIGION



The Kurd - Kurmanjis have followed Islam for many years. Although the New Testament is now available in their language, there are few known Northern Kurd believers.

Ask God to strengthen, encourage, and protect the small number of Kurd - Kurmanjis who are Christians. Pray for open doors to share the Gospel with this people group.

GOVERNMENT



They are divided by both outside influences and internal strife. Politically, they are oppressed by the government.

Pray for the end of political oppression upon Kurd - Kurmanjis. Pray for the LORD to touch the lives of the key leaders among them to share the Gospel boldly.

- Most Syrian Arabs are Sunni Muslims who are dedicated to the ways of Islam. There is a small minority that is part of traditional Christian groups.
- Syrian Arabs are among the peoples who have fled the fighting in Syria in hopes of finding a peaceful home.

Pray for the end of child marriages and the child labor system. Pray for educational opportunities for all the children of Syrian Arabs.

Christians among the Syrian Arabs face persecution.

Pray for the religious freedom of the believers among Syrian Arabs to worship the LORD openly. Pray that Syrian Arab Christians would be protected from harm and persecution.

Pray for the LORD to touch the lives of the key leaders among the Syrian Arabs to share the Gospel boldly.





About The People Group:

- The Kurds are tribal people and many of them lived, until recently, a nomadic lifestyle in the mountainous regions of Turkey, Syria, Iraq, and Iran.
- Today, Kurds are the largest ethnic group in the world without a state of their own.
 Tribalism is still a factor among Kurds, promoting many different factions which weaken the possibility of an independent homeland.
- In Turkey, where the largest contingent of Kurds live (40 %), the Kurds are seen as a threat by the Turkish government, which has continually sought to assimilate the Kurds into Turkish society through forced resettlement.

<u>Available</u> Resources:

- The Holy Bible (complete, both online and offline).
- The 'JESUS' film and other audio/video recordings.

<u>Barriers:</u>

- This people group is strongly fragmented and is often split by internal disagreements.
 So far in history, the Kurds have never really managed to unite in their common cause.
- Many Kurds of the lower regions are not organized in tribes, but even there, strife is common between the different clans and communities.

ECONOMY



Physically, the Kurds live in very poor conditions. Good water supplies are scarce, and they are exposed to diseases such as malaria and tuberculosis.

Ask the LORD to call qualified Christian medical professionals who are willing to go and share their medical expertise as well as Jesus Christ with Kurds.

EDUCATION



Schools are ill-equipped and there are too few of them. Kurds need the liberty to educate their children in their own language.

Pray for the Kurdish children to have access to wellequipped schools, and all other basic needs to continue their education.

RELIGION



The Kurds have followed Islam for many years. Although the New Testament is now available in their language, there are few known Northern Kurd believers.

Ask God to strengthen, encourage, and protect the small number of Kurds who are Christians. Pray for open doors to share the Gospel with the Kurds.
