

Country Background



As persecution rises in Saudi Arabia, the **Persecution Rank** moved to **13th** position in the **World Watch Report 2023** by Open Doors for Christian persecution. Mohammed bin Salman is the crown prince of Saudi Arabia. Saudi Arabia, the home of Islam, has outlawed Churches and punished Christian worship for decades. The kingdom's 1.4 million Christians meet in secret places. According to the human rights report, Saudi Arabia held the presidency of the G20 in 2020 despite the country's longstanding human rights abuses. The Saudi-led coalition continued a military campaign against the Houthi rebel group in Yemen that has included scores of unlawful airstrikes that killed and wounded thousands of civilians. The majority of the Christians in Saudi Arabia are foreigners who temporarily live and work in the country. They are severely restricted in sharing their Christian faith with Muslims and in gathering for worship, which entails the risk of detention and deportation.



In recent months, Saudi Arabia hosted a series of expensive sporting and cultural events to deflect the poor human rights situation in the country.

All women's reforms announced or allowed remain superficial in nature. Rights activists still languish in prisons on frivolous charges. There is still no justice for murdered Saudi journalist Jamal Khashoggi.

Key Prayer Areas



Government



The authoritarian style of governance by the Saudi Royal family grants itself complete control over policies both internal and foreign. The International community tiptoes around Saudi Arabia and rarely takes a strong stance fearing an oil embargo.

- **PRAY** for the **SALVATION** of members of the Saudi Royal family.
- **PRAY** for the **HOLY SPIRIT** to soften the hearts of influential Saudi Royals and prepare them for the **GOSPEL** message of **JESUS CHRIST**.

Migrant Workers



Six million foreign migrant workers are employed by the Saudi Arabian private sector. It is more than 75% of the entire private sector workforce. More than half of this population are expatriates. Domestic workers face serious abuse at the hands of their employers including physical attacks such as beatings, starvation, rape, and other forms of torture. They are also the only population that consists of **Christian Believers**.

- PRAY for the safety of migrant workers in Saudi Arabia.
- **PRAY** for the strategic employment of Christian Believers with businesses or households owned by members of the influential Saudi Royal family.

God's favor for the Expatriates

Pray for the majority of expatriate Christians in Saudi Arabia who besides being exploited and poorly paid are regularly exposed to verbal and physical abuse because of their ethnicity and low status (**The Bible, 2 Corinthians 1:5**).

Pray that Asian and African workers will withstand the mistreatment and profess their Christian faith during their hardship (**The Bible, Job 6:23**).



God's favor for Saudi Women

Pray for the women in Saudi Arabia whose personal rights were completely nullified under the Personal Status Law that came into effect in March 2022 (**The Bible, Luke 1:45**).

Pray that they will find their identities and their authority in Jesus Christ (The Bible, Psalms 27:1).

A Call to Salvation



We declare the rule of Jesus Christ over Saudi Arabia. Embolden the small network of Christians so that they can receive encouragement and discipleship. Use the internet and Christian satellite TV channels to strengthen and grow the Church in Saudi Arabia.
